## RATTO REPORT

In the **San Francisco Chronicle** in December of 2007, Ray Ratto profiled schools that received bowl "invitations despite losing six games" during the regular-season. Through January 3, 2012, a total of 64 schools have entered a bowl game with a 6-6 record or worst with 33 of those schools winning their bowl game. Eight of the 6-6 teams (Oklahoma State in 2006, Alabama 2007, Iowa State 2009, BYU 2010, Mississippi State 2011, Texas A&M 2011, Illinois 2011 and Florida 2012) defeated another 6-6 team (Alabama 2006, Colorado 2007, Minnesota 2009, UTEP 2010, Wake Forest 2011, Northwestern 2011, UCLA 2011 and Ohio State 2012). In 2011-2012, 14 teams enter bowl games with 6-6 or worst records. Four 2011-2012 bowl games (Music City, Texas, Kraft and Gator) featured 6-6 schools.
